



## **TBF Oregon State Team Qualifying Format**

- Top 12 Anglers / (6) Teams - based on team total points with a throw-out, will determine the TBF Oregon State Team (6) Boater (6) Co-Angler Positions to represent Oregon in the Northwest Divisional the following year
  - Teams must declare positions on the team as Boater/Co-Angler at the beginning of the season
  - The team alternate will be the 7<sup>th</sup> Place Team. We will move down the list of finishers until enough team members are selected
  - The State President can also appoint a team member if needed to fill a vacant position
- Contestants will need to fish 3 out of 4 events to qualify for the State Team. 1 Throw-out event is allowed for each team for the season
- Best 3 out of 4 Team finishes based on points, will determine position on the team for Boater/Co-Angler Status
  - Points will be awarded as 100 for 1<sup>st</sup>, 99 for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 98 for 3<sup>rd</sup>, etc, etc, etc...
  - Participants that do not weight fish at an event will receive participation points, which will be 5 points less than the last place awarded
- Teams must fish together the entire season
  - In the event a team member is not able to fish in an event, the other partner may fish alone and score points for the team.
- Big fish for the entire year for the team will break any ties, if in the event of a points tie
- Membership for both TBF Oregon and FLW Outdoors must be current during the time of participating in each of the qualifier and as acting State Team members

## **State Team Responsibilities**

- State Team members may receive a possible travel stipend at the end of the season for related traveling expenses for the Divisional event, if funds are available for distribution
- Volunteer time will be required as a State Team member for special events and projects throughout the year to support TBF Oregon
- If any of the above conditions are not able to be met, or fulfill the obligations, or wishes not to participate, the individual may be removed from the team, and a replacement team member may be appointed by the State President to fulfill the open position
